Job Description for Farmer
“Lokelani ‘Ohana” on Maui, Hawaii

We are seeking an experienced biodynamic farmer that would like to become a member of a Camphill inspired initiative on Maui.

Our wish list for this person is as follows:

- One or more years experience working on a biodynamic farm, involved with farming at a Camphill Community, a Camphill inspired setting, or with a CSA.
- Someone who is interested in working with a one acre of quality beautiful farm on old Hawaiian land that is irrigated with kuleana [be responsible for] water from the valley.
- Someone who is interested in learning about Hawaiian plants and cultural.
- Someone who is supportive of a farming program provided weekly for people of special needs on the land [you may be involved, not required]. Other collaborative programs are in the works.
- Someone that is interested in community networking, delivering fruits and vegetables, attending meetings on occasion, and possibly beginning a CSA. If a CSA is developed, the profits will benefit the farmers income. If the farm simply sells more produce and the profit is increased, the profits are also shared with the farmer. Lokelani ‘Ohana is supportive of educational outreach to the community in biodynamic farming. The farm can be used as a base for classes.

Present Work Exchange Offer:

- The Living Quarters is a large 10x16 foot tent on a 200 sq. ft platform that is covered by a large canopy. The living quarters has a bed, dresser and extra reading lounge chair that can also accommodate another person. A couple is also acceptable. Utilities are provided.
- There is a wonderful 200 sq. foot kitchen and an outdoor shower connected to a nice farm bathroom. The cost for food beyond eating from the garden is open for discussion.
- The work week will be for five days with two days off. We pay a stipend of \$150 a month.
- A car is made available for food deliveries at which time personal errands can be run but not for general use.
- Airfare is paid for by oneself.
- There is a two month trial period for both parties.
- We are hoping to fill a position for six months to one year.
- We presently run a wwoofing program which can continue, in addition to having space for an apprentice.
